

## A BRIEF INTRODUCTION to PPG

Over the years we have grown into what is now classed as a medium/large sized club but have remained a friendly and democratic group of photographers. We welcome anyone with an interest in photography. Our aim is to encourage and advance photography at all levels, beginners to advanced, via lectures, demonstrations, competitions, exhibitions, field trips and interaction of club members themselves.

Our meetings are held on Thursday evenings at 7:30pm (unless otherwise stated) but **unlike other clubs we meet throughout the year**, most clubs only meet in the winter months. From May to August we have field trips to a variety of outdoor locations around West Cornwall and occasionally further afield, then from September to April we meet indoors. In addition to our Thursday programme we also hold up to a dozen day trips at the weekends, these vary from events around Cornwall to a day's wildlife shoot or a day out on Dartmoor.

#### **MEMBERSHIP**

We have a small annual membership fee of £35 but non-members are always welcome to attend the occasional meeting at the guest rate, either to see if they might like to join or simply because they are interested in a particular event.

There is no charge for taking part in our field trips, though we do charge £4 to members and £4 for guests attending our indoor meetings, this helps to cover the costs of hiring the hall, our guest speakers and judges, and the half time light refreshments.

As a member, you will have access to our two 'closed groups' on Facebook, 'PPG Members' for help and advice at any time, and 'The Facebook Mobile Challenge'.

#### **OUR COMPETITIONS**

#### **EXTERNAL COMPETITIONS**

PPG are members of the Western Counties Photographic Federation (WCPF) and the Cornwall Photographic Alliance (CPA). Both the CPA and WCPF hold annual inter-club competitions we enter as a club and several that are for club members to enter as individuals. We refer to these as our external competitions.

**WCPF**: The WCPF have one competition that we enter every year "The Inter-Club Championship" is their new flagship, it includes the old 'DPIC' and 'Print Comp', and normally involves around fifty clubs in the South West.

Other WCPF competitions available to members are:

- Member's Exhibition, prints and digital projected images.
- Knightshayes Trophy, prints.
- AV Competition, audio/visual sequences.
- Kingswood Salver, a panel of prints (inter-club)

**CPA:** The CPA have three competitions that our competitions secretary deals with, these are:

- CPA Annual Competition, this is a club competition for digital images and prints. The
  presentation evening is in May each year and this is judged by top judges from around
  the UK.
- Charles Hosken, this is an open competition is for club members. The presentation
  evening is normally in March. The judges of this competition are now experienced judges
  from around the UK.
- CPA Nature & Wildlife Competition, this again is for club members. The presentation
  evening this year is in November and is judged by top wildlife judges from around the
  WORLD!

The CPA competitions for club members have an entry fee of £1 per image.

#### **INTERNAL COMPETITIONS**

**Penwith League:** This is our internal competition which is held over five evenings. Rounds one and five are open rounds the other three are a mix of categories which includes themes and prints. Since the pandemic we have moved to using judges from around the UK via Zoom, this give us a wider selection of judges to choose from.

<u>Image of the Year</u>: Speaks for itself, we have two categories which are digital and prints, the winner of each appears on our website and the covers of this programme, again judged externally but with a face to face judge if possible.

The 10 Day Challenge: This is fun competition run during the first week in December when you should be Xmas shopping. The challenge has four themes, each with a bottle of wine for the winner. The overall winner on the night get to choose a zoom guest speaker for the following year.
